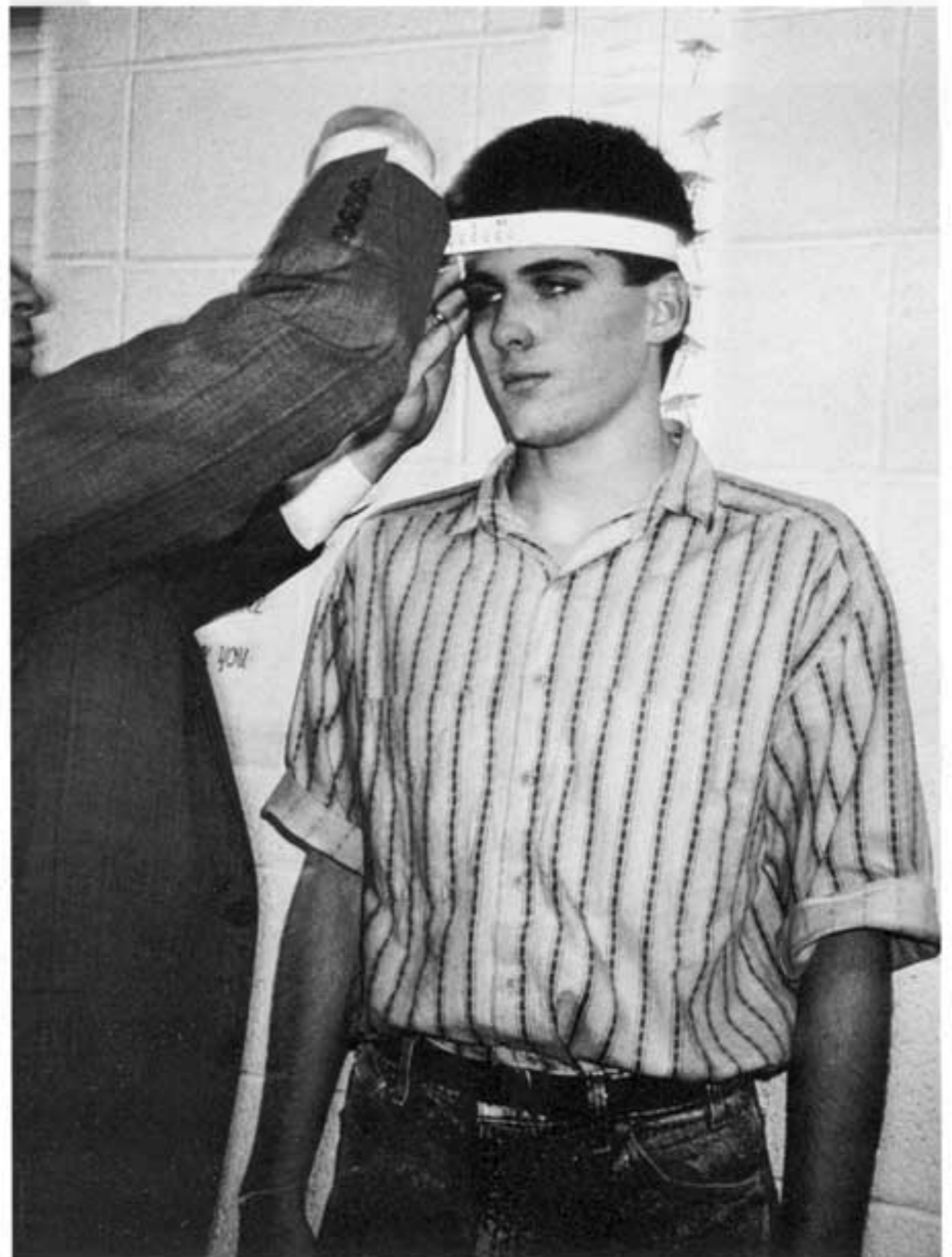
Do We Measure Up?
