

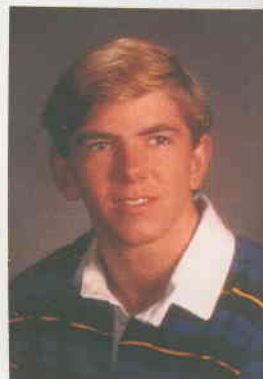
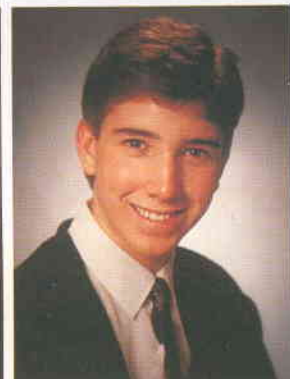

For twelve years Jim Matice has been shooting bow. His dad, Dan Matice, got him started when he was just 6 years old.

Jim is currently a National Champion and has been featured in the July 16, 1990 issue of *Sports Illustrated* and the September 3, 1990 issue, New Faces in the Crowd feature of the magazine.

Tim Hulliberger of the St. Johns Reminder presented Jim with a "Faces in the Crowd" trophy.

Jim holds many records for his talent. He uses a special way to shoot his bow called

String Walking. To String walk, the archer moves his fingers down the string according to the distance from the target. The closer the distance, the fingers are moved farther down the string. The longer distance, the more they are moved up the string.

Jim belongs to Thorney Acres Archery Club and practices 3 times a week. He's hoping for a Scholarship and plans to go to Arizona State University and try to shoot for them. Jim also has his sights on a trip to the Olympics.
