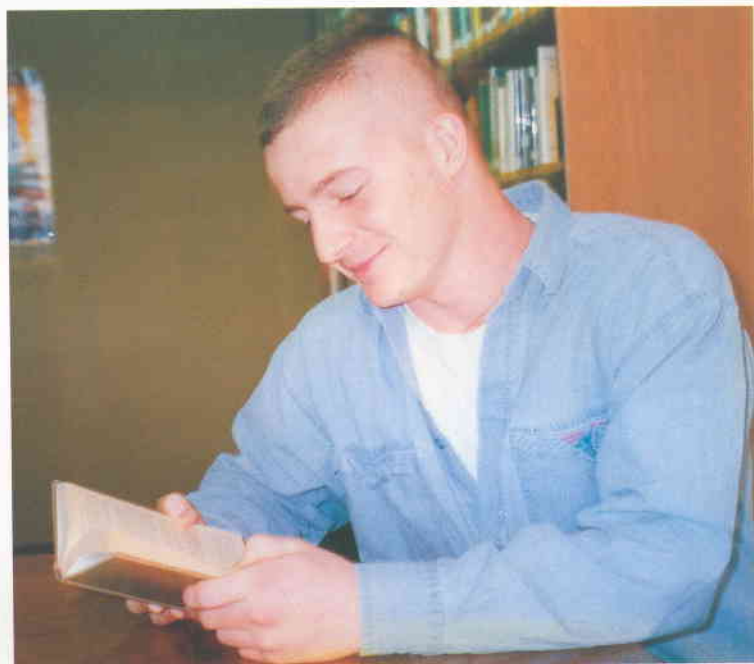
These represent just a few of the many options for those not going to college right away.

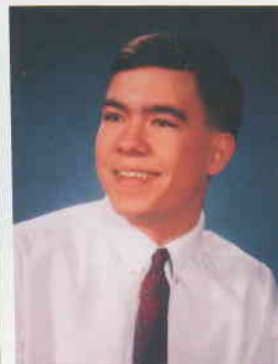


"I will be attending the Air Force Academy in Colorado Springs, Colorado. This has been my goal for a long time," said Senior Gage Anderson. Photo by Hicks
