Parting with friends is often one of the toughest aspects of being a senior.

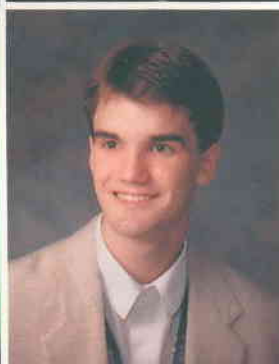
