Ron was born in Zeeland, Michigan in 1938 and soon thereafter moved with his family to Clinton County.

After attending Ovid High School he enlisted in the U. S. Air Force and spent 3 years in France as a GCA Radar Technician on a supply base providing support to all U. S. Air Force



bases in Europe and depot level maintenance on U. S. and NATO aircraft. After his discharge he took a job driving truck and eventually retired as an over the road driver for USF Holland.

Ron and his wife Maxine have been married for 65 years and have four children, seven grandchildren, and seven great grandchildren.

Ron began volunteering at the museum in 2008 and was appointed to the advisory board in 2011. He organized the document room at the museum where documents and photos relating to Clinton County are located. He has researched and written the history of the foundries located in St. Johns and also wrote the history of gasoline and steam engines manufactured here. Ron currently has a Richmond Bro's stationary steam engine manufactured in St. Johns on loan to the museum carriage house.

The CCHS Museum special exhibits for 2025 will commemorate the 100th anniversary of Rodney B. Wilson High School. Rodney B. opened in 1925 as a replacement for Central High School in St. Johns.



The school was named for Rodney **MUSEUM**B. Wilson, a high school student who died of influenza in 1918.

Rodney B. Wilson school served as the St. Johns high school until the current building opened in 1969. It was then used as a junior high until 1998.

Currently the building is being renovated into a mixed use facility with the old classrooms being converted into apartments while preserving the auditorium and gym for public use.
