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HERITAGE HOME TOUR

Saturday, September 14, from 10 a.m. - 4 p.m., the Friends of the Museum will be hosting another Heritage Home Tour. Tickets for the event are \$8 if ordered in advance and \$10 the day of the tour. The tickets can be obtained in advance by mailing an order blank to the Clinton County Historical Society. Order blanks are included in this newsletter, or are available at the Paine-Gillam-Scott Museum, Parr's Pharmacy and the Clinton Avenue Gallery. Pre-ordered tickets can be picked up on the day of the tour or mailed if a self-addressed stamped envelope is included with the order.

This year's tour includes the **Carpenter Home** at 500 East Higham, the **Dorman Home** at 400 South Clinton Avenue, the **Nihart Office** at 218 North Clinton, the **Walbridge Home** at 309 West Baldwin, the **Watson Home** at 504 East Walker and the **Wood Home** at 200 West Cass Street.

Also included in the tour will be the **Clinton County Courthouse**, **Paine-Gillam-Scott Museum**, the **First Congregational Church** and the **St. John's Episcopal Church**.

Special events include a **Victorian Wedding** at the St. Johns Episcopal Church at 11 a.m., 1 p.m. and 3 p.m. The Friends of the Library will hold a **Silent Antique and Collectibles Auction** and a **public luncheon** at the First Congregational Church. Brochure included in this newsletter. ☺

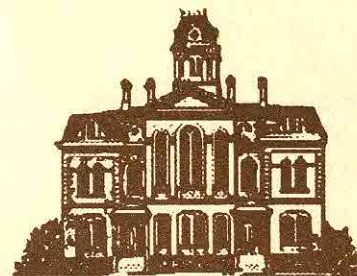
The Clinton County Historical Society was founded in 1974 as an off-shoot of the Bicentennial interest in local history. The first Home Tour Festival was conducted in 1975.

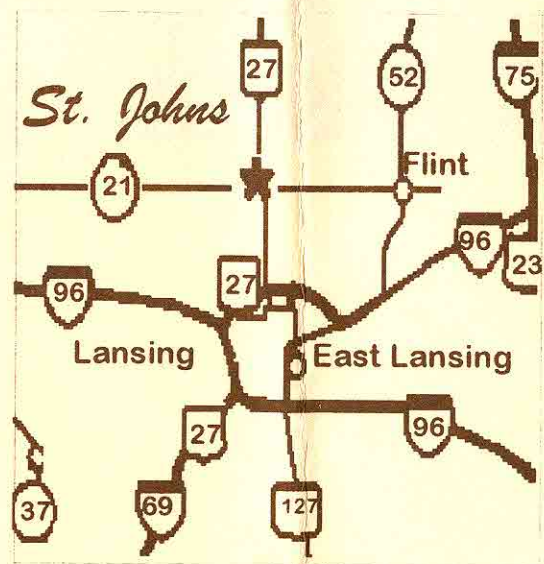
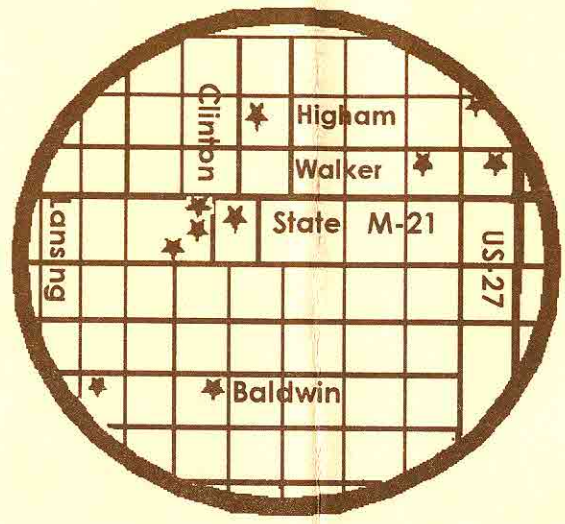
