

HARD WINTERS RECALLS WEATHER OF
SIXTY YEARS AGO
PIONEERS' HARDSHIP IN 1843
WINTER OF 1843-4 THE MOST SEVERE
EVER KNOWN HERE
SNOW WAS OVER THREE FEET DEEP AND
LASTED FIVE MONTHS
TREES CUT DOWN FOR CATTLE TO BROWSE ON

The protracted cold weather has brought out many stories of hard winters in the past. Of these the winters of 1843 and 1844, just sixty years ago, were probably the most severe, and a few old residents in this part of the state still remember the troubles of the pioneers of Clinton and adjoining counties.

Dorr K. Stowell, who is one of the few surviving pioneers whose memory goes back to that period in Clinton County, gives *The News* some interesting facts regarding those times. He was then a boy of fourteen, living with his father's family in DeWitt, where they settled in 1838 on a small open prairie about four miles from the present village of DeWitt. They were among the very first settlers, Captain David Scott's log house and tavern and Samuel V. Smith's blacksmith shop being almost the only buildings at the site of the village at that time, and the surrounding country was an unbroken forest still inhabited by the Indians. There was no road cut out north of DeWitt and the nearest white neighbor was two miles distant.

He remembers that the snowfall was extraordinarily heavy, beginning early in November and lasting into April. About March 29 his father, Dr. Hiram Stowell, who was then county treasurer, set out on horseback for Detroit to make his settlement with the auditor general. Shortly after his departure, Mr. Stowell's little sister was taken sick and he remembers that when he went for a doctor, he waded through snow nearly waist deep in places. Dr. Stowell was gone about ten days, his daughter having died in the meantime, and on his return the first thaw was beginning.

The pioneers themselves did not suffer much from the severity of the

weather, but there was a great scarcity of food for animals, many of which died from cold and starvation. There being no cultivated hay, they depended in those days upon marsh hay for feeding during the winter of which only the usual amount had been secured. It was cut along the river flats in Bath Township and drawn over the snow for use. Marsh hay is poor feed, being not much, if any, more nutritious than straw, and long before winter was over it became necessary to cut down trees for the animals to browse on. Dr. Stowell kept a man busy for two months doing nothing but cutting down trees for this purpose, the cattle eagerly gnawing the moss and bark off the trees and eating the buds and small branches as far as they could bite them off. The deer suffered equally for lack of food and would follow about with the cattle, browsing on the trees. Dr. Stowell had a large number of cattle which in the summer were driven through to New York state and a number of them died from exposure and lack of food. Captain Scott, the first settler at DeWitt, lost a great many hogs from the same cause, and many sheep.

REMINISCENCE OF G. W. STEPHENS

G. W. Stephens, a former pioneer of this county, now of Long Beach, California, adds some interesting reminiscences to those given by Dorr K. Stowell in an interview which appeared in a recent issue of *The News*. He says:

I was greatly interested in the article on pioneer days in your issue of the 18th. I can class myself with those pioneers, for my mother and myself came to DeWitt with my grandfather Hoopie, my mother's father, in March 1845. I was then two years old and saw and realized the hardships of a pioneer life.

A resident of Clinton County for fifty-eight years, I well remember when the county seat was organized at DeWitt. Though a small boy then, I well remember Dr. Stowell as the first doctor in DeWitt. In 1861 I entered the army and was absent from the county a little over four years.

I am now at Long Beach, and it seems like home to see so many St. Johns people here. I had the pleasure of meeting Mr. and Mrs. A. E. Richardson, which was my surprise on returning from the mountains. I understand from them that they have bought the place where they reside, known as the "Old Homestead," a beautiful place, for \$6,000. It is very cheap at that, and they must have made \$1,000 the way property is increasing in value here. There were ninety permits for building last month and a great many improvements including a new pier which will make a great addition to the city. Property has almost doubled in the last three months that I have been here. We have the finest climate in the world. What would you think to walk out to the melon and strawberry fields and pick all you wanted to? This is the place to take comfort in, especially for old people.

- Cleaning blankets: Aply glycerine to raw yolk of eags let soak in and wash out with sopy water.
- Cough Syrup: Ex Wild Cherry (1 oz); paregoric (1 oz); chloroform (1 oz); ex licorice (1 oz); linseed oil (1 oz) glycerine (1 oz); 1 qt water. 2 lbs white sugar. Boil. When cold add the oil.
- Dead Shot to Pane: 1/2 oz oil red cedar; 1/2 oz hemlock; 1/2 oz spirits amonia; 1/2 oz tr capricorn; 1/4 oz camphor; 1/4 oz chloroform; 10 oz. alcohol.
- Bed Bug Medican: 1 pt. of alcohol; 1 oz. corrosive subpliment. Mix the two together and use every morning for a while. Apply with a feather. Pison.
